GETTING Started



WITH YOUR 4-DOOR FRENCH DOOR REFRIGERATOR

BEFORE YOU START

Set up your refrigerator

Remove tape and glue residue from surfaces before turning on the refrigerator. Choose a place near a grounded electrical outlet, allowing for clearances for ease of installation, proper circulation, and plumbing and electrical connections.

Before operating for the first time

After you remove all of the package materials, clean the inside of your refrigerator with soap and water before using it. See **CARE AND CLEANING** in your Use & Care Manual for other cleaning tips.

YOU'RE IN CONTROL

Your controls

Use the +/- buttons to set the freezer and refrigerator temperatures. Allow 24 hours for temperatures to stabilize. We recommend setting your freezer at 0°F/-18°C and your refrigerator at 37°F/3°C.



QUICK CARE

Keeping your refrigerator clean maintains its appearance and prevents odor build-up.

Be gentle

Clean with warm water and mild soap. For stainless steel models only, use **Frigidaire** *Ready***Clean™ Stainless Steel Cleaner**.



SAFE, GREAT TASTING WATER



Your *Pure*Source Ultra II[™] Water Filter is certified to reduce contaminates and keep great-tasting water flowing for you and your family.



Your new PureSource Ultra II™ water filter is located on the top right side of the fresh food compartment.

- Before dispensing water for the first time, be sure to prime the water supply system: 1. Press and hold a drinking glass against the water dispenser paddle until water comes out (it may take up to 1½ minutes).
 - 2. Run water through dispenser for approximately 3 minutes or 11/2 gallons, before use, and discard.

Change your water filter every 6 months to ensure safe, great tasting water.

FAQs

Is it normal for my refrigerator to make noises?

To familiarize yourself with the sounds your new high-efficiency refrigerator may introduce, see the **NORMAL OPERATING SOUNDS** section of your Use & Care Manual.

Why does my refrigerator run most of the time? Is this normal?

Today's refrigerators are designed to be more energy efficient than previous models. This means they run longer cycles, or run continuously, to maintain an even temperature inside. Please note: starting a unit takes about 10 times as much energy as it does to keep it running.
